**Constitution of an Apex Committee on Credit Exemption and Credit Transfer for the students.**

It is already known to all concerned that through our notifications, PU/COE/216/2023 dated 17-10-2023, PU/COE/227/2023 dated 09-11-2023, PU/COE/018/2024 dated 11-01-2024, PU/COE/118/2024 dated 05-03-2024, PU/COE/181/2024 dated 30-05-2024 and PU/COE/193/2024 dated 10-06-2024 all the departments have been empowered to explore the provisions of credit transfer in relation to the credits earned in the equivalent paper/s from UGC recognised platforms/institutes to complete the Degree requirement within the period of validity of University registration for the students.

Further, a committee has also been constituted under the direction of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor during January 2024 (vide our notice no: PU/COE/017/2024 dated 11-01-2024) to explore the provisions of credit transfer (as above) for the Department of Physics.

So far, two students, one from the department of Mathematics (UG) and one from department of Statistics (PG) have been able to complete their degree requirement through credit transfer during the year 2024.

Now after a thorough review of the situation, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to constitute an Apex Committee constituting of the following members to look after the cases of Credit Exemption, Credit Transfer and relevant issues as required from time to time.

Members of the Committee are as follows:

1. Prof. Sankar Bose, Professor, department of Geology, Presidency University.
2. Dr. Zaad Mahmood, Associate Professor, department of Political Science, Presidency University.
3. One member to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor from time to time.
4. The Controller of Examinations, ex-officio Member Secretary

The Committee will meet periodically to consider cases as required and send recommendations if any, based on Extant Examination Regulations of the University and the guidelines of UGC, to the Competent Authority.

The Departmental Academic Committees so far considering the cases of credit transfer, based on applications received from the students will continue to do the same vide our earlier notifications.

The newly constituted committee will start functioning with immediate effect.
